

Q10 If you are a funder, do you consider Te Tiriti o Waitangi when considering grant applications?







Q12 Does your organisation have a specific policy related to climate change?







Q14 Does your organisation have any formal partnerships with other organisations to carry out shared activities?





Q15 How many partnership agreements do you have with each type of organisation?







Q19 Are you aware of the Coalition government's intention to introduce the Living Standards Framework (LSF) and Dash Board?










Q32 How would you rate your organisation's overall commitment to the SDGs?






